From the River Bend Kitchen...

EASY PUMPKIN BREAD

Ingredients:

- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 1 can pumpkin puree 15 ounces
- 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- eggs (see back of your cake mix for how many)
- vegetable oil (see back of your cake mix for how much)
- 2/3 cups chocolate chips (semi-sweet, milk chocolate, or dark chocolate) Sprinkle of powdered sugar for topping

Directions:

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. Prepare a loaf pan for baking quick bread either spray it with a non-stick cooking spray, or line with baking parchment paper. Following the amounts of eggs and oil required for the particular cake mix you bought, mix together the cake mix, eggs, and oil on medium speed with an electric mixer. Keep mixing until the batter is smooth. Add the canned pumpkin and spices to the cake mix mixture and mix until well combined, scraping down the sides and bottom of the pan. Stir in the chocolate chips. Pour into the prepared pan and bake at 375 degrees for 50 minutes. Let cool in pan on a wire baking rack for 10 minutes before removing bread from the pan.

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
